I, the undersigned official veterinarian duly authorized by the Government of Canada do certify that:

1. Canada is free from foot-and-mouth disease, swine vesicular disease, African swine fever, and hog cholera.
2. The animals were kept in quarantine in an establishment authorized and supervised by the CFIA for at least thirty (30) days prior to export.
3. The farm of origin is free from porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome (PRRS).
4. The farm of origin has been free from infectious diseases such as transmissible gastroenteritis, porcine enzootic encephalomyelitis (Teschen/Talfan disease), leptospirosis, salmonella and brucellosis during the twelve (12) months prior to export.
5. The swine for export have been inspected by an official veterinarian prior to export and found to be in good health and fit for transport.
