I, the undersigned official veterinarian, duly authorized by the Government of Canada, hereby certify, after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, that:

1. Canada has been free of FMD, vesicular stomatitis, swine vesicular disease for 2 years prior to export and is free from rinderpest, peste des petits ruminants, contagious bovine pleuropneumonia, rift valley fever, sheep pox, African swine fever and lumpy skin disease for 3 years prior to export. Vaccination against these diseases is prohibited in Canada.
2. BSE is a reportable disease in Canada and the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) has an eradication policy with regard to BSE.
3. Canada has a mandatory national cattle identification program that permits traceability from birth to slaughter.
4. In Canada, it is prohibited to feed ruminants with meat, bone meal and greaves from ruminant. This ban has been effective since 1997.
5. The animal products for export has been slaughtered in a slaughterhouse which is approved by the CFIA and the product has been produced from animal(s) which passed ante and post mortem inspection by the CFIA.
6. The Canadian origin FBS product is from foetus from cattle not known to be related to any bovine herd affected by BSE.
7. FBS exported to Korea is exclusively of Canadian origin.
8. The end product was:
either packed in new sterilized bags,
or transported in bulk containers or other means of transport that were thoroughly cleaned and disinfected with a disinfectant approved in Canada before use.
9. The animal product for export has been produced, processed, stored and transported in such a manner as to prevent contamination by communicable animal disease pathogens up to the point of departure from Canada.
