**IV. HEALTH INFORMATION**

I, the undersigned licensed veterinarian, do hereby declare,

1. The animal has been examined and found to be healthy and free from any clinical sign of rabies and infectious or contagious diseases of dog/cat, at the time of examination and certification, prior to export.
2. No case of rabies has been reported to have occurred in that country or part of the country from where the animals originated or being kept for the last six (6) months preceding the date of the export.
3. The animal had not been imported into the country during the six (6) months preceding the date of the certificate.
4. The animal has been vaccinated against rabies using an approved anti-rabies vaccine, prior to export.
5. The animals shall be vaccinated within twelve (12) months prior to export with other core vaccines as recommended by the licensed veterinarian.
6. The vaccination history status, treatment given and health status of the animal is up to date.
7. The animal has been examined and found to be healthy and free from any clinical signs of rabies and infectious or contagious diseases of dog/cat, within seven (7) days immediately prior to export and showed no clinical signs on the day of shipment.

(1) **List of Banned / Restricted Breed of Dogs:**

Restricted: Bull Mastiff, Bull Terrier, Doberman, German Shepard/Alsatian including Belgian Shepard and East European Shepard, Perro de Presa Canario (also known as Canary Dog), Rottweiler

Banned: Akita, American Bulldog, Dogo Argentino, Fila Brasileiro, Japanese Tosa, Neapolitan Mastiff, Pit Bull Terrier / Pit Bull (also known as American Pit Bull, American Pit Bull Terrier, American Staffordshire Terrier and Staffordshire Bull Terrier)

**Notes:**

- Animals shall be transported via aircraft or other means of transportation direct to the prescribed landing place or any other airport in Malaysia.
- An approval to import restricted breeds of dogs shall be obtained in writing from the Director General of Malaysian Quarantine and Inspection Services Department (MAQIS) prior to application of an import permit. Please contact your local District Office.
